Life unexpected with God

One of our goals here at Aletheia is that we live out our Faith not just on Sundays, but throughout the rest of the week as well. Therefore, we would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Here are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time. We will also discuss these questions in our small group after the service.

And immediately Jesus made his disciples get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away. And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone. But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be you, bid me come unto you on the water. And he said, Come. And when Peter came down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O you of little faith, why did you doubt? And when they came into the ship, the wind ceased. Then they that were in the ship came and worshiped him, saying, Of a truth you are the Son of God. (Matthew 14:22-33)

- When did I go through a storm? What did God do during that time? What was the fruit of that storm?
- When did God rescue me when everything seemed to fall apart?
- Did I ever "stop looking at the storm" and then "look at Jesus instead"?
 What difference did it make?
- In what area of my life is God asking me to "step out of the boat" today?
