Come Home, the Father is Waiting

And they began to be merry. (Luke 15:22-24)

- Do I wholeheartedly believe that God loves me the way He loves the younger son in this parable? Or do I doubt whether this is really true for me personally as well?
- Have I ever personally experienced the restoration of God? Or is it mainly head knowledge about God?
- Is there an area in my life where I live in "the far country"?
- Is there currently a famine in my life that might be from God, because He wants to get my attention?
- Do I see myself predominantly as a servant of God? Or as a beloved Son/ Daughter?
- What does God want me to do to experience the Celebration in heaven over me?
