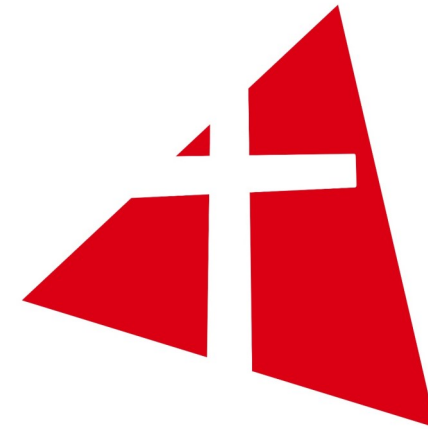

Come Home, the Father is Waiting (Part 2)



One of our goals here at Aletheia is that we live out our Faith not just on Sundays, but throughout the rest of the week as well. Therefore, we would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Below are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time.

Please read Luke 15:11-32 again and/or listen to the sermon again to allow God to speak to you. Then you can pray to Him over the questions below.

And he said unto him, Son, you are ever with me, and all that I have is yours. (Luke 15:31)

- **In what area of my life do I recognize the older brother in my heart?**
- **What is my true identity? Are there aspects of my work, achievements, family, etc. that I embrace as part of my identity?**
- **Did God ever allow my achievements to be taken away, to get my attention? How did I respond?**
- **Do I sometimes believe that „God is withholding from me“ and treating others better than me?**
- **Are there people in my life that I look down on? People groups or nationalities?**
- **Do I sometimes „complain about God“ instead of talking with Him about how I feel?**
- **Do I truly see God as a „heart God“? Or do I believe that I have to earn my approval through my work?**
- **Are there things in my heart that I'm trying to avoid that hinder me from experiencing God's love to the fullest?**
