## Freedom in Christ

One of our goals here at Aletheia is that we live out our Faith not just on Sundays, but throughout the rest of the week as well. Therefore, we would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Below are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty with which Christ has made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

- Do past experiences still affect my life in a negative way?
- Do fears control parts of my life? Am I making certain decisions out of fear? What does that say about my trust in God?
- Do I feel like I have to "proof to God that I am good enough for Him"? Or am I able to truly rest in His assurance that "He saved me by Faith, not by works"?
- Does God's law feel restricting to me? If yes, in what areas? What does this say about my heart?
- What sinful attitudes, desires or motives cause me to not wanting to obey
  God's law?
- In what area of my life do I want God to set me free today?
- What can I do today that would allow me to experience God's freedom in a new way?
