All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- Do I love reading the Bible by myself? Or does it feel more like a duty to me?
   What does my answer say about my heart?
- If I am completely honest to myself: Is the Bible the final and absolute authority in every aspect of my life? Or are there areas where I doubt the Bible?
- What lies of this world do I believe that contradict the Word of God?
- What is the main way in which I learn what God says in the Bible? Can I trust this source? Or do I need to look for other sources to make sure I'm not being led astray?
- Do I verify what preachers say about God? Or do I believe whatever they say, without reading the Bible myself?
- Am I in regular fellowship with other Christians, to discuss questions about the Bible, to gain a deeper understanding?
- Do I read books to get a deeper understanding of the Bible?
- What does God want me to do to get a deeper understanding of His Truth?
