Prophecy

One of our goals here at Aletheia is that we live out our Faith not just on Sundays, but throughout the rest of the week as well. Therefore, we would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Below are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time.

Please feel free to listen to the sermon again to allow God to speak to you a second time. Then you can pray to Him over the questions below.

1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the others judge.

- Does my understanding about God mainly come from my own time with God, and reading the Bible? Or do I rely too much on others to tell me the Truth about God?
- Do I have friends that I can trust that I can talk to when I have questions about God and the Bible? Do I want to ask God to bring such a person in my life?
- Do I know the general direction that God is calling me towards in the next 5, 10, 20 years of my life? Are there things in my life that I know that I know that God wants me to pursue?
- If I do have a general direction that I know God is calling me to: Does it help me discern God's will for my life today?
- If I don't have such a general vision for my life: Do I want to ask God to give me such a vision?
- Am I giving God room to speak to me when I need to make decisions? Or do I quickly act without Him? How can I give God more room to direct my life?
