We would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Below are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world gives, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

- Which of the Names of Jesus in Isaiah's prophesy speaks the most to me?
 Why? (Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace)
- What is my definition of peace? Is it in line with the way the Bible defines peace?
- In general, would I say that I experience peace in my life? Or would I describe my life more in terms of fears, anxieties, etc?
- In what area of my life do I generally not experience peace? Is there a connection between my lack of peace and a lack of Faith/Trust in Jesus in this area?
- How do I currently deal with my anxieties? Do I bring them to God in the way that Phil. 4:6-7 describes? How can I deal with my anxieties in a way that pleases God more?
- What is my plan for this Christmas season? Do I plan to put efffort into entering God's rest? Or do I try to find rest by "doing nothing"? Do I want to adjust my plans/schedule in some way, to truly find peace and rest in Jesus?
