## *Who am I?*

One of our goals here at Aletheia is that we live out our Faith not just on Sundays, but throughout the rest of the week as well. Therefore, we would like to encourage everyone to reflect on today's sermon over the next few days. Below are some questions that could help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time.

Please feel free to listen to the sermon again to allow God to speak to you a second time. Then you can pray to Him over the questions below.

*1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own; that you should show forth the praises of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvelous light: Who in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: who had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.*

- If I had to pick three words trying to describe best „who God is“: Which ones would I pick? Are these words in line with what the Bible says about God?
- What aspect of God from the Bible do I struggle with the most? Do I know why I struggle believing this aspect of God?
- If I had to pick three words to describe my identity in Christ: Which ones would I pick? Can these words/descriptions be found in the Bible?
- What aspects of my identity in Christ do I struggle with the most? Do I know why I have difficulties truly believing this aspect of my identity?
- What life experiences have impacted me that make it difficult for me to fully believe who God is/who I am?
- Is God calling me to step out in Faith in an area of my life? If yes: Is a false image of God or myself the reason why I haven't taken that step yet? What can I do to overcome the obstacle?
