




- •




WHO YOU ARE NOT

• We are who God says we are!




2 IDENTITIES

- Those who live eternally separated from God


SELF IMAGE

• Who I think I am




SELF IMAGE

Our self-image often covers our identity




PERSONAL EXAMPLE

WHY DOES IT MATTER?

• We live our lives out of our view of God and ourselves

Israel didn't have to wander through the wilderness for 40 years


Numbers 13:2 Send men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall you send a man, every one a leader among them.

Numbers 13:27-29 And they told him, and said, We came unto the land where you sent us, and surely it flows with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it. Nevertheless the people are strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and along the Jordan.

Numbers 13:31-33 But the men that went up with him said, We are not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we. And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that eats up its inhabitants; and all the people that we saw in it are men of great stature. And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, who come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

- God gave them a promise
- But they didn't expect that they would have to move in Faith
 - Step out into a dangerous situation BEFORE God performs the miracle

- They saw God's miracles
- They knew God COULD do it again
- They didn't trust He WOULD do it again
 - Wrong image of themselves
 - Wrong image of God



THE RESULT

- 40 years in the wilderness
- None of the people who received the original promise were allowed to enter the land
 - except Joshua and Caleb, who wanted to take the land

THE LESSON

- God keeps His promises
- We sometimes do not receive God's promises because of
 - A wrong image of who God is
 - A wrong image of who we are

LET'S MAKE IT PERSONAL

- Many of us have seen God's goodness, faithfulness, love, miracles,...
 in the past
- But we often have doubts about our future


A NAGGING QUESTION

We wonder whether God will do it again

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.

o God might have given you a promise too




WHAT ABOUT US?

 - Do we trust that God will keep His promises?
 - Do we trust that God sees us the way He says He sees us in His Word?
