Below are some questions that could help us all reflect on today's sermon and to go deeper with God during our quiet time this week.

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- If there was one thing that God spoke to me to put into action through today's message: What would it be?
- Would I say that I know God? Know who I am in Christ? Know what God's will for my life is?
- What sources have shaped my view of God in a wrong way in the past? Are
 there sources in my life today that tell me wrong things about God? What
 can I do to limit the influence these sources have on my life?
- How would I answer the same questions when it comes to sources that have influenced my self-image in a negative way?
- Am I "wearing" the armor of God, to defend myself against the devil's schemes? (esp. the "Belt of Truth", the "Shield of Faith" and the "Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God", Esp. 6:13-18)
- Would I say that I am putting my Faith into action Monday to Saturday? In what area(s) of my life do I want to honor God more?
- Am I proactive in living out my Faith, to know God's Truth, to know my new identity in Christ, and to know God's will for my life? Or am I passive, waiting for God "to do everything for me"?
