Who am 1? (Creation and Fall)

Below are some questions that could help us all reflect on today's sermon and to go deeper with God during our quiet time this week.



Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

- If someone on the street asked me what the purpose of my life was: What would I answer? Why?
- Do I see sin as something that really harms me? Or do I see it more like an external law? (e.g. "As long as I don't get caught, it's OK.")
- Do I feel fulfilled in my life? What is the source of my fulfillment?
- Am I striving to find fulfillment in worldly things? Or am I truly content and fulfilled in Christ alone?
- What God-given desires do I pursue in my own strength, instead of asking Jesus to fulfill them?
