FRIENDSHIP

Psalms 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!

Ephesians 4:3 Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Ephesians 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ:

ON THE OTHER HAND

The Bible also warns us to keep clear boundaries

Ephesians 5:3 But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it <u>not be once named</u> among you, as becomes saints; (KJ2000)

But among you there must <u>not be even a hint</u> of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are **improper for** God's holy people. (NIV)

BOUNDARIES

 Do not give ANYBODY the slightest possibility to speculate what's going on!

BOUNDARIES

• These boundaries apply to anybody except your spouse

BOUNDARIES

Type of boundaries

- Physical boundaries
- Emotional boundaries

Matthew 5:27-30 You have heard that it was said by them of old time, You shall not commit adultery: But I say unto you, That whosoever looks on a woman to lust after her has committed adultery with her already in his heart. And if your right eye causes you to offend, pluck it out, and cast it from you: for it is better for you that one of your members should perish, and not that your whole body should be cast into hell. And if your right hand causes you to offend, cut it off, and cast it from you: for it is better for you that one of your members should perish, and not that your whole body should be cast into hell.

• The person of the other gender we are relating to

- As soon as we have given a person of the other gender an objective reason to wonder whether we are sending out any kind of romantic/emotional message,... we have committed sin!
- It is our responsibility that NO PERSON of the other gender will get the opportunity to misinterpret anything we say or do as romantic advances

 The tricky part: What's normal for me among friends could be interpreted as intimate by the other person


- People who observe how we relate to people of the other gender

 - Actions speak louder than words


COMMON SOURCES OF MISUNDERSTANDINGS

- Flirtatious behavior




Some boundaries that we keep

We won't travel with a person of the other gender


• We are very careful about physical touches




 We try to avoid praying one-on-one with a person of the other gender
