

Below are some questions that could help us all reflect on today's sermon and to go deeper with God during our quiet time this week.

John 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, That you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

For everyone

- If I look at the list of "10 needs": Which 3 would I pick as "most important to me" for my future marriage?
- If I assume for a moment that my future spouse has the typical top 5 needs: Which one would be most difficult for me to give? How can I prepare myself today so that I can offer that need to my future spouse once I am married?

For Married People

- Do I know the top needs of my spouse?
- Does my spouse know my top needs?
- Do we have regular conversations about how we can meet each other's needs in a better way?

A challenge for all married couples

Each partner picks <u>one(!)</u> need they feel isn't fully met today. Share with each other and make a commitment to improve in this area over the next month. Settle a date night (without kids) in around one month and talk with each other if there is any change in your relationship.
