



TODAY'S PASSAGE

2 Timothy 3:14-17 But continue in the things which you have learned and have been assured of, knowing of whom you have learned them; And that from a child you have known the holy scriptures, which are able to make you wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

CONTEXT

- Paul is Timothy's mentor
 - This is probably the last letter of Paul we have
 - Paul was warning Timothy of deception and persecution he would have to face

2 Timothy 3:12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

2 Timothy 3:14 But continue in the things which you have learned and have been assured of, knowing of whom you have learned them;


2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child you have known the holy scriptures, which are able to make you wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 3:17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.


PAUL'S TRAIN OF THOUGHT

• The situation is going to get worse and worse




THE VERSES BEFORE

2 Timothy 3:1-9 This know also, that in the <u>last days perilous times shall come</u>. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, truce breakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. For of this sort are they who creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with various lusts, Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the <u>truth</u>. Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the <u>truth</u>: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.

 - And they will only increase




OUR TIME

- But we all face challenges




STEPS WE COULD TAKE
