Listening to God

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- Is „hearing God's voice“ and „being guided by God's voice“ something that describes my everyday's life well? Or is that more the exception than the norm?
- What has been my definition of „prayer blockers“ before today's sermon? Did it change in any way?
- What role does „seeking“ play in my prayers? Are there other things that I'm seeking more than God's guidance?
- What role do „sins of omission“ (as opposed to „sins of commission“) play in my prayer life?
- When does/did God speak to me the most/most clearly/most often in my life? When is/was it most difficult to hear Him? Can I see a connection between the „prayer blockers“ we heard about today and when God does/did (not) speak to me?
- If I had to pick one of the prayer blockers from today's message: Which one of them is preventing me from hearing God's voice the most right now? What does God want me to do to remove it?
