God's Guidance

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct your paths.

Below are some questions that can help us all go deeper with God during our quiet time this week

- The verse above has three responsibilities for us (Trusting, Not leaning on our own understanding, Acknowledging God). Which of these three am I good at? In which of these areas does God want me to improve?
- In who or what in this world do I sometimes trust more than God? In what situation(s) does this show?
- The writer of Psalm 32 talks about „not being like mules and horses“: Which tendency do I generally show more?
- Is there a call from God on my personal life right now where I am like the horse or like the mule?
- Is there something in my life where I am procrastinating and not heeding God's voice (yet)? Is it time to act on what He has been saying to me?
